IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

On Sunday 17 May 2026, the Outlaw Nottingham Triathlon event will be held at The National Water Sports Centre. We are expecting upwards of 1500 athletes taking on the challenge of a 1.2 mile swim, a 56 mile cycle and a 13.1 mile run. Many of the athletes will be raising funds for Alzheimer's Research UK who are our official charity partner of the event.

In order to facilitate a safe event for all there will be some traffic management measures on the bike course, which we would like to inform you of so you can make any necessary adjustments to your plans. These will be in place from early in the morning and we will do our best to remove them as soon as the last cyclist has passed.

KEY INFORMATION TO NOTE WHEN PLANNING YOUR JOURNEY

- The Outlaw Half Nottingham Triathlon is a major event with 1500 participants. If you have any journeys planned, please allow additional time.
- All Stop/Go Boards will operate during the times that the cyclists are passing through the junction to ensure the cyclists can make turns safely.
- Road Closures are in place for safety reasons and signed diversion routes will be in place. These road closures will be removed as soon as the final cyclist has passed through the area and it is safe to reopen the road.

DIVERSIONS

Each of the diversions that are in place as a result of any road closures will be fully sign posted. Please ensure you follow the signage. Diversions routes for any closures can be seen below, with the times that we are expecting the diversions to be in place.

RADCLIFFE ON TRENT – NOTTINGHAM ROAD [04:00-12:00]

Nottingham Road access off the A52 will be closed, with a signed diversion being via Cropwell Road.



EAST BRIDGFORD ROAD [06:00-11:00]

East Bridgford Road will be closed in both directions, with the diversion being via Main Street and Bridgford Street via Newton island.



SCARRINGTON – HAWKSWORTH ROAD [06:00-12:00]

Hawksworth Road is closed with a signed diversion route via Mill Lane to Aslockton, Cliffhill Lane and Longmoor Lane.



SCREVETON - HAWKSWORTH ROAD [06:00 - 10:30]

Hawksworth Road will be closed from the edge of the village with a signed diversion via Car Colston and Car Lane



ELSTON VILLAGE - PINFOLD LANE [06:30-15:30]

Travelling from Eden Hall / A46 Lodge Lane will be closed at Pinfold Lane. There is a signed diversion turning left onto Pinfold Lane. Low Street then onto Toad Lane.



HAWTON VILLAGE - HAWTON LANE [07:00-11:30]

Hawton Lane Closure at Newark Road junction. The diversion is via Farndon on Newark Road / Hawton Road turning left onto Boundary Road, onto Farndon Road onto Fosse Road, crossing the A46 island onto Fosse Road.



THANK YOU

We expect all of our athletes to behave in a courteous and considerate manner, but on occasions a small minority let the side down. We would ask for your help in curbing any less than desirable behaviour. If you see an athlete littering or behaving in an antisocial manner, please note their race number, which should be visible on their back and also the seat post of the bike. If you contact us on 07979 666452, with details of the incident, we will then disqualify the athlete concerned. This number will only be monitored on the day of the event so please do not use it for general enquiries.

As organisers we appreciate that the traffic management implemented for the event, and in some places the volume of cyclists on the road, may cause inconvenience, for which we apologise. We thank you for your patience and support, with and for our athletes, many of whom are taking part to raise money for charities.
